IS PRAYER A PRIORITY?

We're currently working through a series of Sunday messages called "From Breakdown to Breakthru," all about how we can get past the breakdowns that we all deal with and experience God's breakthru in various areas of our lives.

It doesn't take a certified mechanic to see that our world is in the throes of a serious breakdown! Around the globe, we're fighting a deadly health crisis against an invisible virus. In our nation, we are experiencing turmoil as we reckon with racism and its effects. And here in our community, people are suffering from anxiety, fear, pain, and uncertainty.

So, what can you and I do to "fix" the ills of our society? How do we best invest our God-given time and energy to make a difference?

One word: **PRAY**

There's no better tool than the power of prayer!

Can prayer combat our anxiety? It sure can – in fact, scripture tells us that it is the antidote to anxiety... prayer enables us to trade our anxiety for God's peace:

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."

– Philippians 4:6-7

Can prayer bring about the healing that our country (and our whole world) desperately needs right now? Yes! Look at what God told Solomon about how Israel could experience God's healing breakthru:

"If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."
