TRUSTING GOD FOR THE FUTURE

Each week during the past couple of months we have been looking at and talking about God's promises from the Bible.

Throughout the Old and New Testaments, God includes thousands of promises to us to give us a foundation to cling to during difficult times and to help us experience spiritual growth at all times.

My prayer is that this series of messages has helped you in both of these areas – stability during tough times and encouragement for spiritual growth – as you have been reminded of God's promises.

In fact, just this past Sunday we discussed God's promises to us about an aspect of life that tends to leave us anxious and uncertain: the future.

If you missed it, here's a quick recap of the six guarantees from God for my future:

- 1) God promises to guide me when I'm confused.
- 2) God promises to help me when I'm tempted.
- 3) God promises to support me when I'm in trouble.
- 4) God promises to repay those who hurt me.
- 5) God promises to reward my service and generosity.
- 6) God promises to keep me saved until heaven.

In short, the overall takeaway from last Sunday's message was that God isn't bound by time or space like we are – He is God and we are not.

Because of that, He has your past, present, and future covered. God's very nature is faithful and you can trust Him with that which is unknown to you and me.

Our memory verse for this week speaks to this faithful nature of God:

“For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.” – Philippians 1:6 (NASB)


I consider myself an optimist, but even so, a sober assessment of our country and our world right now definitely brings with it concerns about the future.
