A CANVAS FOR THE MASTER

This past weekend we began our new summer teaching series, *Character Builder: Lessons from the Men & Women of the Old Testament*, with a look at “Noah: A Picture of Faith.”

Together, through July we’re looking at different characters from God’s Word and focusing on a specific trait that He developed in their character. More importantly, we are digging into how God can develop those same character traits in us as He continues to paint the masterpieces of our lives.

Last Sunday’s message on Noah gave us a chance to briefly discuss the amazing Biblical account of Noah & the great flood. We talked about Noah’s faith and how he spent decades building an ark the length of 1½ football fields and preparing for a flood on a scale that the world had never seen before (or since). That faith led him to take God at His word and do what He said.

If you and I are going to allow God to keep painting the masterpieces of our lives with brush strokes of faith, we need to cooperate with Him in the same way. It’s unlikely that God will call you to build an ark any time soon, but who knows what profound acts of faith He has on the horizon for you, me, or our church?

To prepare ourselves and develop our “faith muscles” to respond to God’s call, I shared this weekend that we should *TAKE SMALL STEPS OF FAITH EACH DAY*. These small steps of faith help us to honor God, demonstrate His priority in our life, and allow us to be faithful in the small things to prepare for larger things.

Here are the examples I shared:

- Bible Study
- Prayer

- Acts of Kindness toward Others
- Doing What’s Right

Remember what Ephesians 2:10 says:

“For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.”

Long ago – before we ever thought about it – God planned good things for you and I to do. Every day that we wake up, He has set aside *something* for us to do that will allow Him to paint a few more strokes of faith into our lives if we’ll look for these opportunities and take advantage of them.

What’s it going to be for you today? *Maybe a phone call or text message to someone you know who is going through a tough time?* Perhaps an unexpected handwritten note to someone you haven’t seen in a while? *You could pay for the person’s food behind you in the drive thru line or grocery store.* Or at the very least, share a kind word that demonstrates God’s love to whomever He places in your path.

Here’s what I know: the more I look around with “Holy Spirit eyes,” the more opportunities I see to serve others, share God’s love, tell people about Jesus, and invite them to church. Because God laid out the plans long ago for me to do so.

Will you commit with me to open our eyes in the coming days for these opportunities and step up, in faith?
