PEOPLE GOD USES

Many times, we are totally unaware of the things God is doing in our lives or how long He has been guiding us without our knowledge. We also are unaware of the people that we influence and what a difference it makes. There are also times we would like to go back and redo things in our lives, yet if we saw the whole picture, we might not change them (I'm not talking about sinful things but things we are embarrassed about or things we could have done better). Let me explain by telling a story of two men and how their lives shaped history.

The year was 1939; a father took his nine-year-old son to a movie called, "The Code of the Secret Service." This boy's name was Jerry Parr. Jerry was amazed by what he saw and for him a dream to become an agent was born. The other man who would shape history was a young actor in the film by the name of Ronald Reagan. Reagan would later say it was not one of his best works and it was very cheaply made.

As you might have already guessed, Jerry's dream became a reality as he was accepted into the Secret Service. He continued to achieve and was granted a position on the President's detail. Ronald Reagan continued to make movies, better ones and his fame rose. He entered politics and became Governor of California. He later won the Presidency. Yet neither of the two realized all that God was doing through these many years. On March 30th, 1981, Jerry Parr would save Ronald Reagan's life. As a shooter open fired on President Reagan, Jerry grabbed him by the belt and pants and threw the President into the limo and ordered the driver to go. While in the car Jerry realized something wasn't right and changed the destination to the hospital where the doctor's found that the President had been shot. Jerry's actions had saved Reagan's life twice.

A movie Reagan would probably have rather redone or wish he hadn't made ended up being the thing that saved his life.

We really don't know the magnitude of our influence on others or the blessings that can come from it.

Sometimes people learn from our weaknesses and mistakes. Other times they look beyond them and see the character and heart instead of the actions. This can be clearly seen when God describes David in the Bible. God always said David was a man after God's own heart in spite of his failures. God has a great plan for us and the people we will come into contact with. We must continue to seek Him with all our heart even through the times we don't see His hand at work. God always has big things instore for us and others.
