The Parable of the Prodigal Son – Luke 15:11-24 (NLT)

¹¹ “Jesus told them this story: ‘A man had two sons. ¹² The younger son told his father, “I want my share of your estate now before you die.” So his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons. ¹³ A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land, and there he wasted all his money in wild living.

¹⁴ About the time his money ran out, a great famine swept over the land, and he began to starve. ¹⁵ He persuaded a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. ¹⁶ The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.

¹⁷ When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, “At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger!

¹⁸ I will go home to my father and say, ‘Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, ¹⁹ and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant.’”

²⁰ So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him.

²¹ His son said to him, “Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.” ²² But his father said to the servants, “Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet.

²³ And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast, ²⁴ for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found.” So the party began.’”

1. ADMIT THAT I HAVE _____ FROM GOD.

2. DECIDE TO _____ TO GOD.

So he returned home to his father..." – Luke 15:17-20 (NLT)

"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before..." – Acts 3:19-20 (NKJV)

3. RECEIVE _____ FROM GOD.

"...And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him." – Luke 15:20 (NLT)

4. ACCEPT _____ IN GOD'S FAMILY.
