5 REASONS I CAN RELY ON JESUS AS THE MIGHTY GOD:

1. JESUS IS _____ (ALL-_____).

“...but Jesus stooped down and wrote in the dust with his finger. They kept demanding an answer, so he stood up again and said, ‘All right, but let the one who has never sinned throw the first stone!’” – John 8:6-7 (NLT)
(Jesus) *“I tell you the truth, when you were young, you were able to do as you liked; you dressed yourself and went wherever you wanted to go. But when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and others will dress you and take you where you don’t want to go.” – John 21:18 (NLT)*

“Now we are sure that You know all things, and have no need that anyone should question You. By this we believe that You came forth from God.” – John 16:30 (NKJV)

2. JESUS IS _____ (ALL-_____).

“Jesus answered, ‘I tell you the truth, before Abraham was even born, I Am!’ At that point they picked up stones to throw at him. But Jesus was hidden from them and left the Temple.” – John 8:58-59 (NLT)

“‘Can anyone hide himself in secret places, so I shall not see him?’ says the Lord; ‘Do I not fill heaven and earth?’ says the Lord.” – Jeremiah 23:22 (NKJV)

*(Jesus) “...And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”
– Matthew 28:20 (NLT)*

3. JESUS IS _____ (ALL-_____).

“For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.” – Colossians 1:16-17 (NKJV)

“Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light.” – Genesis 1:3 (NKJV)

“Great is our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding is infinite.” – Psalm 147:5 (NKJV)

(Jesus) “The Father loves me because I sacrifice my life so I may take it back again. No one can take my life from me. I sacrifice it voluntarily. For I have the authority to lay it down when I want to and also to take it up again. For this is what my Father has commanded.” – John 10:17-18 (NLT)

4. JESUS IS MIGHTY TO _____ ME FOR ETERNITY.

“For the Lord your God is living among you. He is a mighty savior...” – Zephaniah 3:17 (NLT)

“The Son radiates God’s own glory and expresses the very character of God, and he sustains everything by the mighty power of his command. When he had cleansed us from our sins, he sat down in the place of honor at the right hand of the majestic God in heaven.” – Hebrews 1:3 (NLT)

“I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me, for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else. No one can snatch them from the Father’s hand. The Father and I are one.” – John 10:28-30 (NLT)
