AT THE CROSS WITH THE CONDEMNED CRIMINAL

Luke 23:32-33, 35-43 (NLT)

³² Two others, both criminals, were led out to be executed with him. ³³ When they came to a place called The Skull, they nailed him to the cross. And the criminals were also crucified—one on his right and one on his left.

³⁵ The crowd watched and the leaders scoffed. ‘He saved others,’ they said, ‘let him save himself if he is really God’s Messiah, the Chosen One.’ ³⁶ The soldiers mocked him, too, by offering him a drink of sour wine. ³⁷ They called out to him, ‘If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!’ ³⁸ A sign was fastened above him with these words: ‘This is the King of the Jews.’ ³⁹ One of the criminals hanging beside him scoffed, ‘So you’re the Messiah, are you? Prove it by saving yourself—and us, too, while you’re at it!’

⁴⁰ But the other criminal protested, ‘Don’t you fear God even when you have been sentenced to die?’ ⁴¹ We deserve to die for our crimes, but this man hasn’t done anything wrong.’ ⁴² Then he said, ‘Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom.’ ⁴³ And Jesus replied, ‘I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise.’
