

## **NEVER MORE LOVED**

One of my favorite activities each week is singing worship songs with you during our in-person Sunday worship service. I am glad we're able to offer church online for people who are checking us out and for those who can't physically attend in-person, but there is something powerful about being in the same room, singing the same songs of praise and worship to the Lord. For me, it serves as a reminder of who God is and what He is doing in the lives of His people.

I may have mentioned that my singing voice is, well, *unpolished* Thankfully (for all of us), our team of production volunteers keeps the volume turned off on my microphone as I sing along on Sunday mornings.

The words and the title of this song echo one of the names and traits of God, that He is our great provider. In Genesis 22, as Abraham is prepared to sacrifice his son to the Lord, God provides a ram for him to sacrifice instead. The next verse says:

"Abraham named the place Yahweh-Yireh (which means 'the Lord will provide'). To this day, people still use that name as a proverb: 'On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided.'" – Genesis 22:14 (NLT)

When was the last time you took a few minutes out of your day to pause and remember all that God has provided for you?


Can you do that now? Count your blessings and thank God for how He has provided for you.
