## NEVER MORE LOVED

One of my favorite activities each week is singing worship songs with you during our in-person Sunday worship service. I am glad we're able to offer church online for people who are checking us out and for those who can't physically attend in-person, but *there is something powerful about being in the same room, singing the same songs of praise and worship to the Lord.* For me, it serves as a reminder of who God is and what He is doing in the lives of His people.

I may have mentioned that my singing voice is, well, *unpolished* 😊 Thankfully (for all of us), our team of production volunteers keeps the volume turned off on my microphone as I sing along on Sunday mornings.

There is a place where I will sing to the top of my lungs... in my truck. When no one else is around or even if my family is riding with me, there are some songs that I just *have* to sing along with when I hear.

One such song on Christian radio these days is called "Jireh," sung by Elevation Worship and Maverick City Music. The first part of that song gets me every time:

*I'll never be more loved than I am right now  
Wasn't holding You up  
So there's nothing I can do to let You down  
It doesn't take a trophy to make You proud  
I'll never be more loved than I am right now, oh  
  
Going through a storm but I won't go down  
I hear Your voice  
Carried in the rhythm of the wind to call me out

The words and the title of this song echo one of the names and traits of God, that He is our great provider. In Genesis 22, as Abraham is prepared to sacrifice his son to the Lord, God provides a ram for him to sacrifice instead. The next verse says:


