

SETBACKS & COMEBACKS

Can you believe it's August already? Despite the consistent summer heat, it's time once again for teachers and students to get back to school. This also serves as a transitional point for all of us. As we say goodbye to July and hello to August (and all that entails), I wanted to share with you this week about setbacks.

In many ways, the past decade in my life has been full of ups and downs. Unfortunately, my ongoing headache disorder continues to flare up periodically and interrupt all aspects of my life: my family, my ministry here at the church, and any projects I have been working on. These periodic setbacks (like the one I'm just recovering from) are frustrating, discouraging, and disappointing.

While we all face different challenges, I imagine you can relate to this idea. We all face setbacks from time to time and perhaps you're dealing with one now. Maybe your current setback is a financial one and you're trying to weather the storm without digging a bigger hole. Perhaps your current setback is relational, and you are working to strengthen or repair the bonds of a broken relationship. Or maybe you, like me, are working your way through a health setback and you're not sure what the next steps are going to look like. Regardless of what type of setback you see in the windshield of your life, I want to remind you today that you are not alone!

In fact, God Himself makes clear that He will not leave His people alone when setbacks arrive:

"When you go through deep waters, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown. When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up; the flames will not consume you. For I am the Lord, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. " – Isaiah 43:2-3 (NLT)

The God of the universe promises to walk through those difficult times with you. There is no promise in scripture that God will prevent you from having to face setbacks. We live in a fallen, sinful world after all. But He *does* promise to accompany you, no matter your setback. It's part of God's very nature!

And not only will the Lord walk with you through your setback, He will get you through to the other side. In other words, God will be with you through your setback, and He will set up your *comeback*. Another aspect of God's character and the way He relates to His people is His promise to take broken pieces and bring about good:

"And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them." – Romans 8:28 (NLT)

Whether you're in the middle of a setback or beginning to regain your footing, focus your attention on Jesus and trust Him with your comeback!
